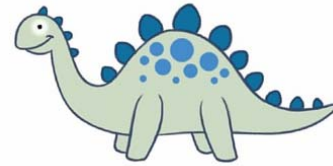
**I need a home for my dinosaur.

But he also ate the spoon.

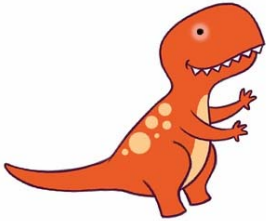
