## Actions - Did You Ever See a Snowman?

**Did you ever see a snowman** – hand above eyes, scanning side to side

**On a warm winter day** – hand wipes your hot forehead OR fan yourself with your hand

**Drips** – right hand “dripping” motion

**Drops** – left hand “dripping” motion

**Slips** – both hands sliding forward and upward away from body

**Slops** – both hands back down and toward body

**Did you ever see** – scan the sky for a reindeer

**Reindeer** – touching the top of your head with your thumbs and spread the fingers out to create the antlers

**Cold winter day** – arms across the body, hugging yourself and rubbing your arms with your hands to keep warm

**Christmas Eve night** – continue doing the reindeer action

**Flies and he glides** – arms out to the sides as if flying

**Runs** – move arms as if running, but feet do not move

**Hides** – put both hands in front of face, palms inward

**Did you ever see** – scan the sky for snow

**Snowstorm** – hands rotating in circular movements in front of the body

**Blows** – hands out and upward

**Swirls** – hands flat and swirling around each other downward back to centre of body

**Twists and twirls** – any circular hand motion

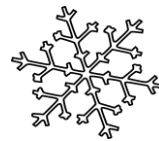
### Alternate winter lyrics to replace “Christmas” lyrics in verse 2:
